- 1. Courses that have gone through review process expert subcommittee of PG Board of Studies following international peer reviews (with a review tool) with following resolutions:
 - a) Part A provides the list which will be part of the LL.M. specialization of European Union Legal Studies (Minimum 10 Students) and will be offered in the group of courses for other specializations of LLM (Max. 50 Students). Further, these courses will be reviewed in UG Board of Studies to be provided as part of Honours Programme across specialization groups (Minimum students 20 each course and maximum 200 students per year).
 - b) Part B provides courses will be reviewed in UG Board of Studies to be provided as part of Honours Programme across specialization groups (Minimum students 10 per each course and maximum 120 students per course). Simultaneously, some of these courses will be offered as Value added courses across all programs, once a semester
