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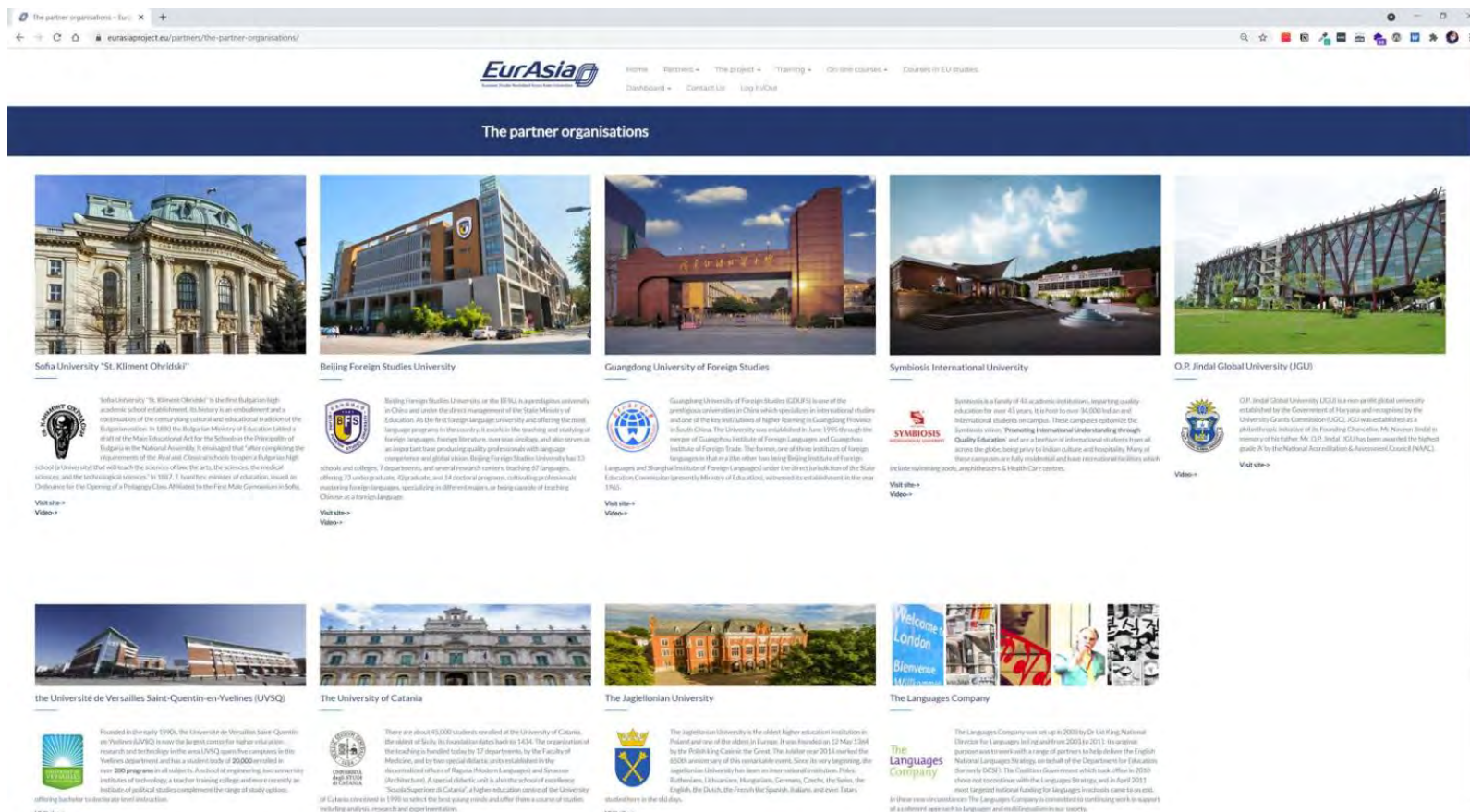



### What does the EURASIA project hope to achieve?

As part of the Capacity building programme the EURASIA project aims to introduce high quality European studies programs in Indian and Chinese universities, increasing the visibility of Europe-related topics through the creation of networks in the field. - To support teaching staff and young researchers by providing opportunities for training, mobility and sharing best practices in teaching and training.

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



When logged in, they see the documents section. It is only available to them. All partners see it, but only some have the right to upload documents.

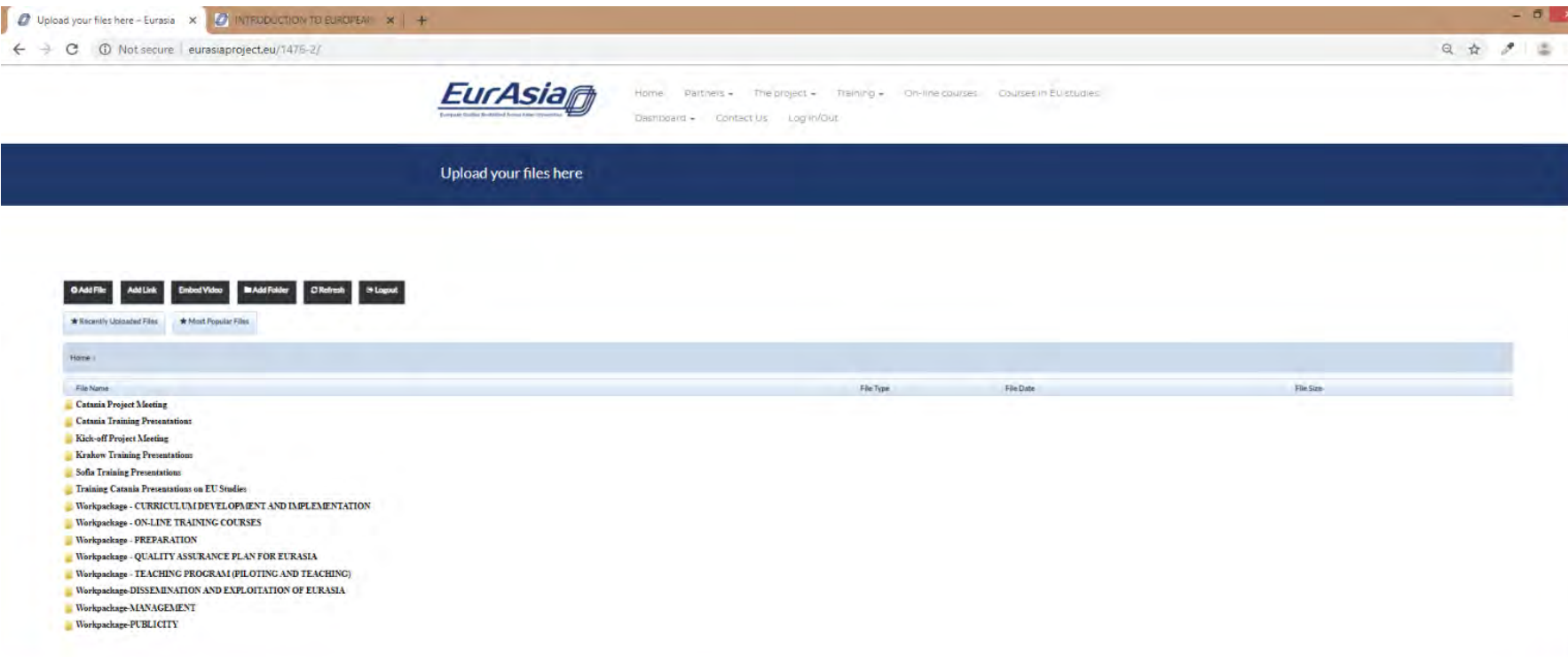
The document and file upload sections are located in the Dashboard.
